



**PUNJAB CANCER REGISTRY REPORT-2025**

**Background information**

- The Punjab Cancer Registry (PCR) was set up in 2005, in Lahore.
- The Shaukat Khanum Memorial Trust is sponsoring the Registry.
- The Registry has 30 collaborating centers.
- The Registry has 55 members including a 8-member Governing Council.

**The 2025 preliminary report**

- Geographic area under study: the Lahore district, Punjab, Pakistan.
- Period being reviewed: January 01, 2025-December 31, 2025 (1-year).
- Total: 8,913 new cancer diagnoses reported.
- Female: 5,083 (57.03%); male: 3,829 (42.96%); neuter: 1 (0.01%).
- Adults: 8,289 (93%) and children (<= 18 yrs.): 624 (7%).
- This is a report on top 10 cancers only. Therefore, the total does not add up to 100%.
- This is a preliminary report and will be updated based on the availability of data.
